Green Cleaning Recipes



All Purpose Cleaner

Ingredients:

1/2 cup vinegar

1/4 cup baking soda

2 litres water

Step 1. Combine the ingredients into water

Step 2. Store in spray bottle

Step 3. Shake before each use

Green Cleaning Recipes



All Purpose Soap

Ingredients:

2 cups soap flakes

4 litres water

25 drops essential oil (optional)

Step 1. Melt soap flakes in hot boiling water

Step 2. Stir until soap is dissolved

Step 3. If desired add essential oil once cooled

Green Cleaning Recipes



Liquid Laundry Detergent

Ingredients:

2 cups soap flakes

2 cups washing soda

9.5 litres water

Step 1. Melt soap flakes in hot boiling water

Step 2. Stir until soap is dissolved

Step 3. Add washing soda to hot soap and stir very well

Step 4. Use 1 cup per load.

Green Cleaning Recipes



Powder Laundry Detergent

Ingredients:

1 cup washing soda

1 cup baking soda

60 milliliters liquid castile soap

Step 1. Combine the powders together

Step 2. Add the liquid castile soap

Step 3. Mix all ingredients together and make sure to break up any clumps

Step 4. Use 1/4 cup per load of laundry
